- ◇ Minutes away from Interstate Highways 287 and 280 and State Highways 24 and 202.

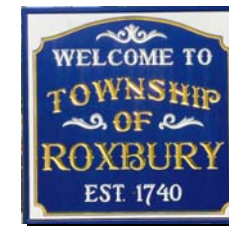
