

Welcome to Roxbury Township, New Jersey The Gateway to the Lake Hopatcong Recreational Area

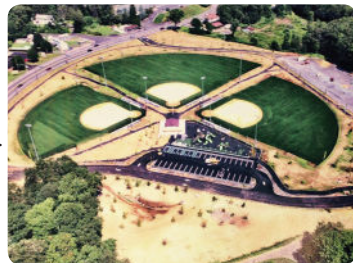
Located about 36 miles west-northwest of New York City, Roxbury is one of the largest geographic townships in Morris County. Founded in 1740, Roxbury Township played a crucial role in the history of the United States. We provided iron ore and forges that supplied George Washington's Continental Army. By the 19th century Roxbury was an industrial hub supplying water from Lake Hopatcong to power the Morris Canal System. By the 1880s we boasted two railroads that spurred economic growth and the town prospered.

Today, approximately 23,000 people live in Roxbury which consists of six unique communities: Kenil, Landing, Ledgewood, Lower Berkshire Valley, Port Morris and Succasunna.

- Award winning Horse Shoe Lake Complex, the gem of our park system offers swimming, year-round sports & recreation activities. Annual events include the St. Therese Carnival, PuptoberFest, BBQ Beach Blast, 2 car shows, town-wide garage sale, regional baseball and soccer competitions.
- 10 soccer fields, 13 baseball/softball fields, plus fields for lacrosse and football.
- 16 Parks with nearly 9 miles of scenic riding & walking trails, state of the art kids play stations and the new Lake Shore Playground and Landing Road Recreational facility.
- Lake Hopatcong State Park also offers extensive swimming, boating and hiking activities.
